Mixed with theatre and artistic skills, Esther and Jonas create characters and stories as life throws them at us – stories we know, love and hate.

LE BISTRO, is a street show of its own kind.



LE BISTRO lives from the drama, the artistic proficiency and the interaction with the audience. The production is created especially for the street as it deals with the specific circumstances of the open-air situation.

A construction for aerial acrobatics allows playing at height and defines the stage area in 3D. The construction and a bar shape the heart of the production. The atmosphere of a bar of the thirties is created. The props, costumes and the stylish selection of the music reflect this atmosphere.

The music, consisting of the best tracks of Benny Goodman, Django Reinhardt and more, puts the audience back in the golden years of swing and jazz.

Esther and Jonas Slanzi are the circus/theatre company E1NZ. The group was founded in June 2011 with the aim of combining contemporary theatre with circus. After Nischenprojekt 2012 and ZWÄI 2016, LE BISTRO is the third production of the company.

Trained at the circus schools in Bristol and Berlin, on tour around the globe, they love the challenge of non-verbal communication. 
